

HTML: List Format

■ Unordered List (Bullet List)

- `` ``
 - Attributes: TYPE=DISK SQUARE CIRCLE
Won't work with IE 4.0
- `` List item

■ Ordered List (Number List)

- `` ``
 - Attributes: TYPE=1|a|A|i|l, START=n
- `` List item
 - Attributes: TYPE=1|a|A|i|l, START=n
